How Rebox helps a dairy manufacturer become more operationally efficient

OVERVIEW

Manufacturing plant operators are asked to flatten boxes and place them on pallets or in gaylords, at the front or end of each line. Once they're full, we'll facilitate a trailer swap, so that you can continue collecting boxes.

CHALLENGE

Level of productivity is at the forefront of manufacturing plants' key performance indicators. However, a dairy manufacturer in Texas was failing to boost operational efficiency, due to the plant's use of a baler which affects time and labor. The bailing process involves seven steps: break boxes down, place them in a bin, move them to a baler, place the boxes in the baler, bale the boxes, remove the bale and move the contents to a trailer. The bailing process requires at least three employees, additional space on the plant floor and significant time dedication, which negatively impacted efficiency for the dairy manufacturer.


